Responsible to:	Finish Line Area Manager
Roster:	Sunday 15th October, 7:00am until 2:00pm.
Sign In:	Volunteer Marquee – MCG external concourse (next to Gate 2 entry)
Role:	To assist with the finish line area.
Duties:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Meet the finish line area manager &/or CPEC captain at 6.45 at the Volunteer Marquee. - Familiarise yourself with the finish Line area – Including location for competitors from the various events to collect medals, receive refreshments (drink and fruit), where to collect competitor gift, obtain a massage (Full & Half participants only) and seek medical attention. - All volunteers to be in place by 7:30am at the very latest - athletes begin crossing the finish line from 7:55am. <p>Two Main Roles:</p> <p>Finish Line Volunteer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Assist in keeping the finished athletes moving past finish line to reduce congestion. - Please ensure spectators stay off the track. - Provide encouragement to finishing athletes. - Provide directions to athletes to specific areas e.g. refreshments, medals <p>Catchers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Work in groups of two - Escort any seriously exhausted athletes to medical assistance.
Note:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All events finish on the MCG - Marathon participants will collect their medal, drinks, fruit & massage down through the players race into LB2 under the Ponsford stand. - Half, 5k & 3k participants will be directed up into the various stands to collect medals & to LB1 in the Ponsford stand for drinks & fruit. - 10k participants will be directed into the Bullring Bar on LB1 in the Members Stand - Make sure you know the public access flow so as to direct people in and around the finish area.
