Warm Clothing Drop Off & Collection

Responsible to:	Warm Clothing Area Managers
Roster:	Sunday 13 th October, 4:45am start (various finishing times, please see roster).
Sign In:	Volunteer Marquee – MCG external concourse (next to Gate 2 entry)
Role:	To assist the drop off and collection of athlete warm clothing.
Duties:	 There are three warm clothing areas: Marathon, Half Marathon & a combined area for 10km, 5km & 2.5km. Each area has its own Manager so please make yourself known to them on arrival Meet the warm clothing area manager at 4:45am at the Volunteer Marquee. All volunteers to be in place by 5:15am at the very latest. Prepare area according to area manager requests. Competitors will drop off clothing before they begin their event and they will collect once completed. Each competitor will be wearing their race bib which includes a tear off strip to attach to their clothing bag. Drop off: Competitor to tear off strip from race bib and attach to clothing bag. You are then required to place clothing bag into allocated box – write the box and bay reference numbers on the competitors race bib (this part they keep for reference when collecting their belongings). Collection – Match number on strip attached to bag with the number on the competitors race bib. If information matches, then hand over the competitor belongings. Control the flow of the competitors - keep area clean and clear from any debris (e.g. rubbish). Assist with the pack up of equipment.
Note:	 Please seek assistance from area manager if the number on the competitor strip and race bib does not match. LOCATIONS: Marathon Warm Clothing: Located on level B2 car park, inside car park entrance A – access via Brunton Ave. Half Marathon Warm Clothing: Through Gate 1 on Level 1 10k (5k & 2.5k) Warm Clothing: Opposite Gate 3 on MCG Concourse Both car park Entrance A and Gate 1 & 2 will be open to the competitors from 5:30am.
